Penria Civic Center Food and Beverage Regulations

 Savar/ASM retains the sole and exclusive rights to all food and beverage sales at the Peoria Civic Center. The following fees may apply to all forms of food and beverage sampled or sold by outside venders:

A.) \$300 per event, up to 4 event days. Vendur move-in / move-out are consider event days. B.) These fees are due before the start of the event and are non-refindable.

- Coca-Cola Bottling Company retains all and exclusive beverage sales and advertising rights. Coca-Cola Bottling Company products must be purchased from Savor/ASM.
- 3.) You may not sell any items that are in direct competition with the Concession Mean being offered during the event.
- You must meet Provia County Health Department guidelines and obtain a daily operating license/ temporary food license.
- 5.) You must have adequate liability insurance and poorf of such insurance supplied to Savor/ASM prior to the event.

Sampling and/ or Civerway of Food and Beverage

- 1.) You must meet Peoria County Health Department guidelines.
- You must have adequate liability insurance with proof of such insurance supplied to Savar/ASM prior to the event.
- 3.) Samples are limited to 1 ex. for heverages and 1 ex. for food items.
- 4.) Sampling of alcoholic beverages by an outside vender is NOT permitted by Peoria city heper codes. The only way alcohol for sampling may be offered, is to have Saver/ASM staff handle / minitur / work your booth during operating hours (labor fees apply). Please call for forther information.

Please center your Catering Manager at to take care of fee payments, to arrange staffing for any alcohol sampling and / or any questions you may have.

Request for Food Sampling / Sales

Fond and Reverage Service - all food and beverage served at the Penrin Civic Center will be prepared, served and/or supplied by ASM's concessionnice, (SAVOR ... Penrin) onless previously agreed in writing. In the event that written permission is granted, the container shall strictly adhere to the following:

- No alcoholic beverages may be served by anyone other than ASM's concessionaire.
- Cocs-Cola products have exclusivity in the Peonis Civic Center. Any sample of Cors-Cola products meet be produced through ASM's concessionaire.
- Beins add by ASM's concessionaire may not be sold or given samy by any other entity.
- Sample size is limited to 1 oz. for alcoholic or non-alcoholic beverages and 1 oz. for food.
- 5. A sample of any faul item sold or given away and proof of food and beverage liability insurance must be provided to ASM's concessionaire prior to the start of your event. All food sold must be in retail parkaging only with the intent for consumption off premise.
- Fund or beverage may not be sold or given away within 50 feet of any permanent or temporary ASM concession operation.
- 7. You must meet Penris County Health Department guidelines. Any final or beverage service during a public event is subject to Health Department inspection. Please contact the Penris Health Department (109-679-6161) prior to your surival to ensure that all cleanliness guidelines have been met and to obtain your duily operating license if deemed necessary by the Penris County Health Department. IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO CONTACT THE PEORIA HEALTH DEPARTMENT PRIOR TO YOUR ARRIVAL.
- You must provide proof of \$1,000,000 liability insurance coverage listing SAVOR and the Peorie Civic Center as other insured. Proof of said insurance must be supplied to Saver/ASM prior to the event.
- You may not sell any items that are in direct competition with the concession mean being offered during the event unless approved by Sovur/ASM. A \$300 fee will apply if sale/sampling approval is given.
- 10. Saven/ASM, the bulder of the PCC liquor license, must handle all skoholic beverages, no exceptions. A flat fee of \$75 per staff member will be required for up to 4 hours of service. Additional hours requested or required will be charged at \$18.75 per hour per staff member after 4 hours. Labor fees are due prior to the event stat.


